

BEQUESTS TO THE SECULAR FRANCISCAN ORDER

With a gift in your Will, your generosity will enable the Secular Franciscan Order to continue the work of helping others for many more generations.

If you already have a funeral plan in place, consider asking for donations in lieu of flowers at your funeral to support the Secular Franciscan Order. (Funeral Directors can arrange to have special envelopes made available at the funeral service).

Also, as part of your funeral plan, ask if the Funeral Director can notify the Secular Franciscan Order of your transitus passing, so that we are able to attend your funeral and continue praying for you. (OFS Rule #24)

HOW TO REMEMBER US IN A WILL

The following wording may be used when writing your Will:

I give and bequeath,

- The whole (or #%) of the residue of my estate
- The whole (or #%) of my estate
- The sum of \$(amount) or
- Details of specific asset(s)

to the Secular Franciscan Order Inc., of Australia, No: Y 14127-46, for the general and charitable purposes of the National Fraternity of the Order, and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper Officer of such Order shall be a sufficient discharge to my Trustees for payment of such legacy.
